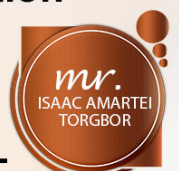
Mr. Isaac Amartei Torgbor also supported the church in diverse ways, contributing to the growth and development of the congregation.

## A TIME FOR EVERYTHING

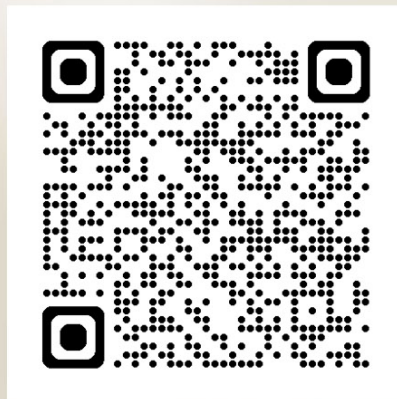
To everything there is a season,
